Elder’s Comments When was the last time you invited someone to church? Does the church offer something that people need? Is there a greater need for the lost than what the church provides? Jesus Christ "also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring us to God" (I Pet.3:18). Jesus now gives us the responsibility to bring people to Him, so that He may bring us all to God. He invites and calls us through His Gospel (II Thess.2:14). We must preach and teach the Gospel to call souls to God and to see them born again (I Pet.1:22-25). Let's begin again inviting people to church. Some have never heard the truth of the Gospel. Some have heard it and fallen away. Both need our love and encouragement to come and hear it before it is too late. Let's think about it and do it!	

LOVE ONE ANOTHER

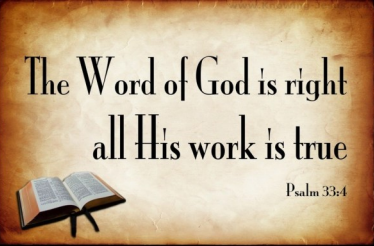
John 13 records stirring, emotional and convicting details about the life of Jesus. It’s in this chapter that Jesus lowers Himself and washes His disciple’s feet and gives His disciples a “new commandment” to love another. Jesus loved His disciples and showed it by washing their feet (John 13:1). He wants them to imitate Him and “wash one another’s feet” (John 13:14). He also wants them to imitate Him, saying, “you love one another; just as I have loved you, you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another” (John 13:34-35).

The defining characteristic of Christian discipleship is love. The greatest way to show love to one another is service. Jesus embodies both love and service and calls us to imitate Him. This is how the world knows that we follow Him; His love and service continue through our attitudes, words and actions.

John 13 also contains other events. It is in John 13 that Judas, with freshly washed feet, walks away from the Lord to betray Him (John 13:30). It is also here where Jesus predicts that Peter will deny Him three times (John 13:38). John 13 reminds us of powerful self-sacrificial love of Jesus, but it also reminds us of the disciples’ failure to live up to it. Yet Jesus loves anyway.

This chapter looks so much like the church. We have been served and washed by Jesus, stand in awe of His goodness, we are called to imitate Him, we strive to show the depth of His love and service towards one another, but we fail so often. Yet Jesus loves us anyway. Even in our failures, the brightness of God’s love shines through. I’ve never felt or experienced the love of God more closely than when I’m among His people, trying, failing and trying again.
