# DO TWO WRONGS MAKE A RIGHT?

Some people seem to be of the opinion that if you do wrong, rather than to admit it and accept the consequences, you simply cover it up or commit another wrong, and everything will be alright. However, is this in keeping with biblical teaching? Is such action even logical and reasonable? Consider the following....

It was reported that twenty-five percent of the cheerleaders of a Texas high school football team became pregnant out of wedlock. That was four out of sixteen! They were dismissed from their cheerleading because of their poor example. The school board made a policy that no one could hold an elected office in the school if they are the parent of a child, which would include the boys too. One of the four pregnant cheerleaders aborted her child, and as a result she was reinstated as a cheerleader. Her lack of restraint and fornication were wrong! She, as well as the father of the child, should have been held accountable for their actions. They should have been punished which would have shown that such behavior is not acceptable.

Everyone must learn that there are consequences for wrong doing. God has reserved sexual intercourse for marriage. (I Cor.7:2-5) It is wrong, immoral and sinful outside of marriage. (I Thess.4:3-7) Abortion also is wrong, immoral and sinful. It is murder, and no one has the right to take another person's life. (Rom.13:9) However, this young woman was rewarded for taking the life of her child through the abortion. In her sight, the second wrong made the first one right. The other three dismissed cheerleaders accepted the responsibility of bearing and rearing their children. If they follow through and become good parents, then a precious and commendable "right" will follow a grievous error. Committing another wrong to cover up the first one may be the easy answer for the time being, but it is never the right answer.

Two wrongs do not make a right! Some people lie, and when caught, they lie again to cover up the first lie. Some steal, and when caught, they lie about it. Cain was wrong when he failed to worship God as instructed, and he did not become right when he killed his brother. (Gen. 4) Aaron did wrong when he made the golden calf for the people, but he did not become right when he blamed it on them. (Ex.32) King David committed adultery with another man's wife, and when he could not cover it up, he did not become right when he had her husband killed. (II Sam. 11) Peter denied Jesus three times before he finally repented and made it right.(Luke 22:54)

Wrong is wrong and right is right, and we must recognize the difference between the two. Two wrongs do not make a right any more than two rights make a wrong. We must submit to God's standard of right and wrong
